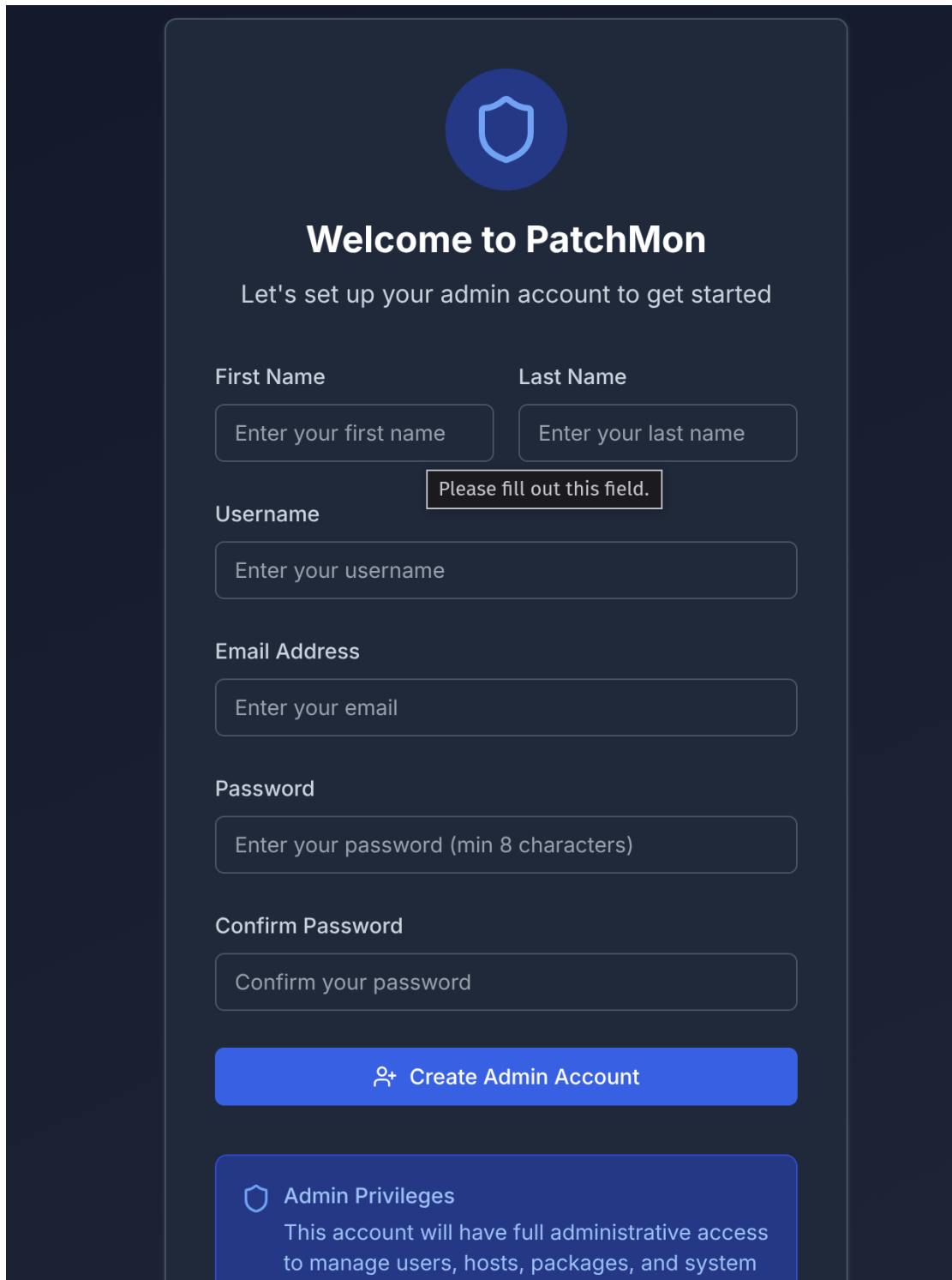

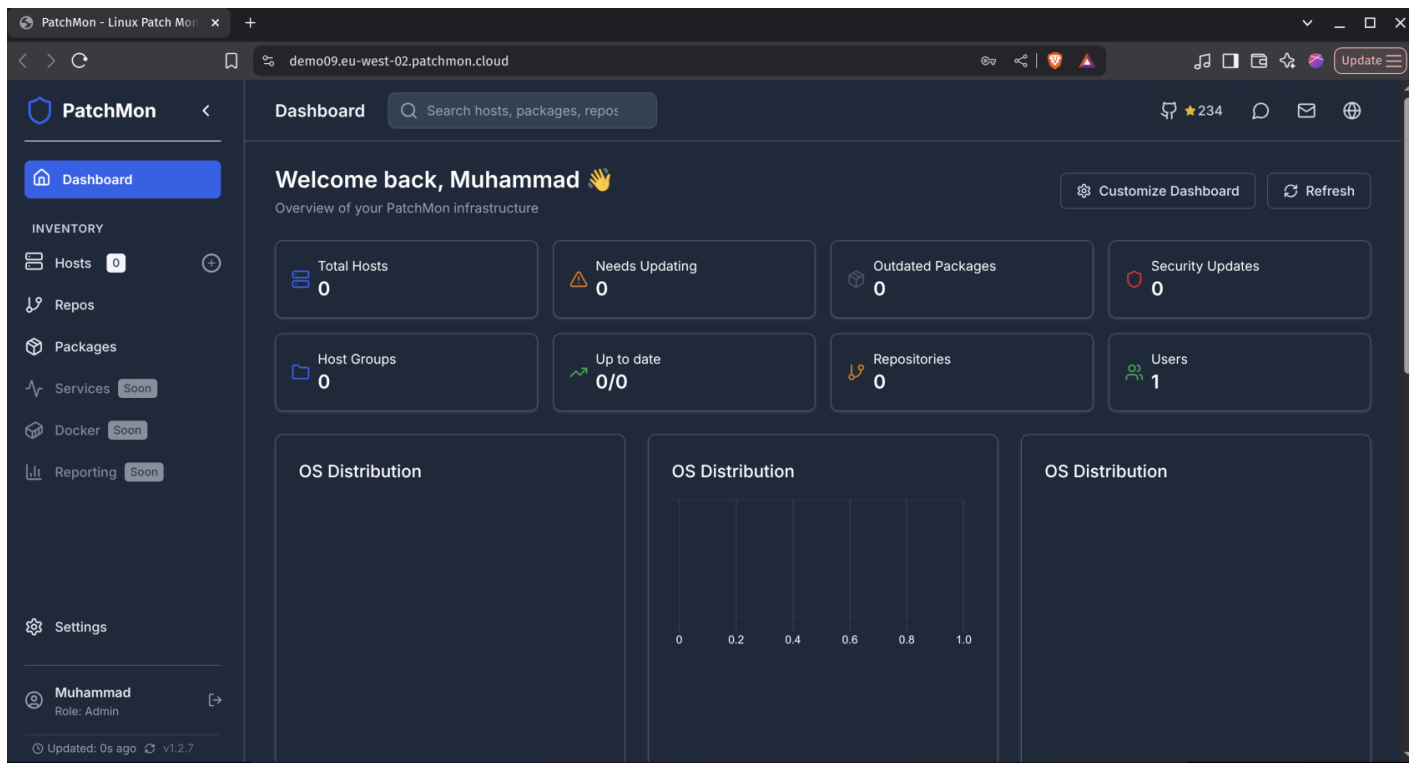

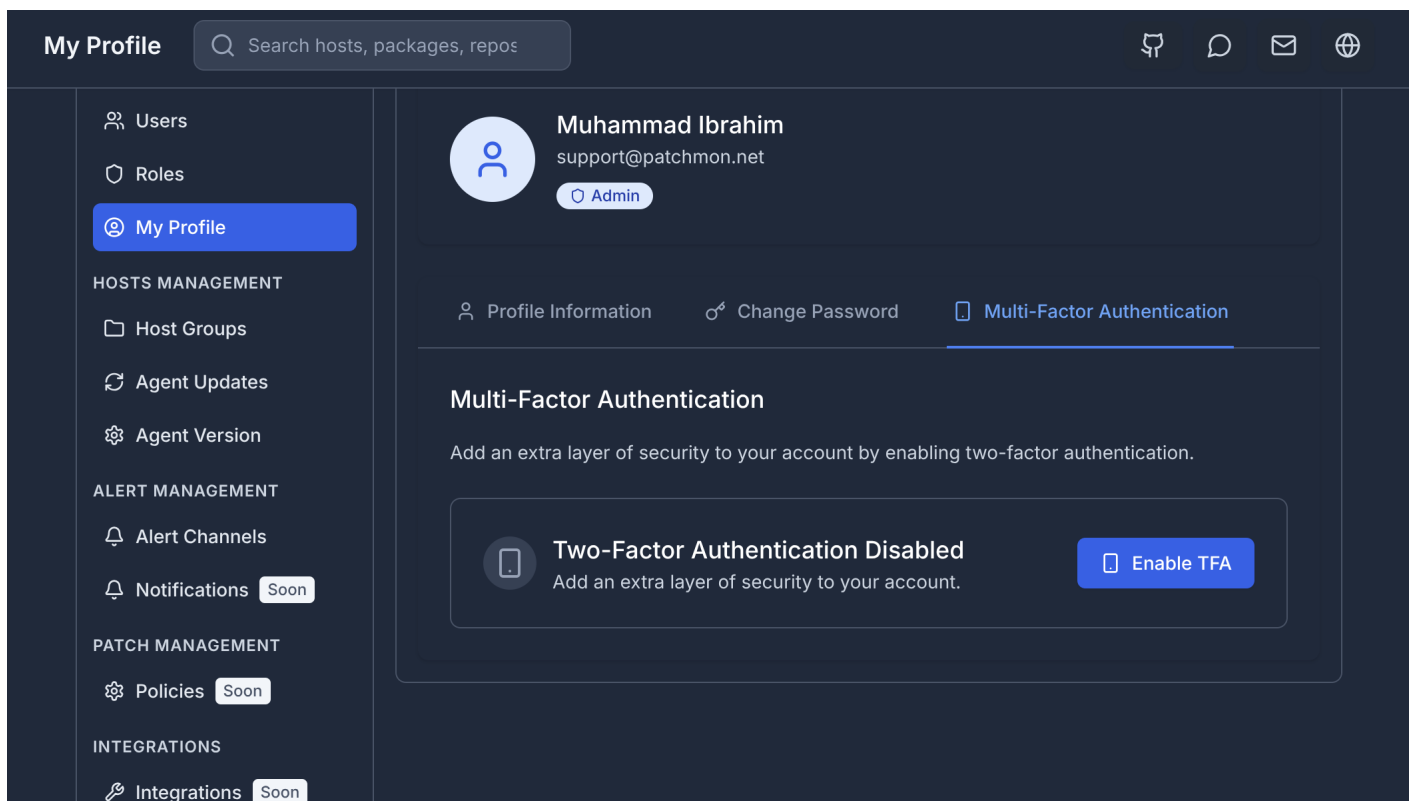
Enter the details and your password (min 8 characters).
